

CAREERS OUTSIDE ACADEMIA

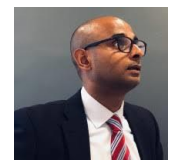
We are pleased to announce that for our RHB 789: Seminar in Rehabilitation Science course, we will have eminent speakers who will speak about careers outside academia.
