"Developing and Translating mHealth Technologies from Laboratory to Community for Individuals with Spinal Cord Injury"

Dr. Hiremath's research talk will focus on three aspects of mobile-health (mHealth) based physical activity monitoring in individuals with spinal cord injury (SCI). First, he will present their work on development and evaluation of physical activity monitors in wheelchair users with SCI. Second, the use of mHealth technologies to provide behavior-sensitive just-in-time physical activity intervention in the community. Third, lessons learned in engaging social connections to promote mHealth-supported physical activity interventions in individuals with SCI.
