**DIRECTOR, NATIONAL INSTITUTE ON DISABILITY, INDEPENDENT LIVING,  
AND REHABILITATION RESEARCH (NIDILRR)**

Dr. Forber-Pratt began her research career in 2006, and her primary area of expertise is disability identity development. Prior to joining NIDILRR, she served as assistant professor at Vanderbilt University. In addition to teaching and mentoring students at all levels, she served as principal investigator for research projects covering a range of disability issues. A two-time Paralympian and medalist in the sport of wheelchair racing, Dr. Forber-Pratt has dedicated her life to helping others recognize their potential.
